Battle Rage Ballerup 2024

26-27th October 2024

Traditionally our tournament was a Warhammer Fantasy Battle tournament with 5 games scheduled during a weekend. With the transition to Age of Sigmar, the tournament has been on a halt. Now we are finally in a place where our community has grown to a size where we are ready to reintroduce our tournament. We have no expectations of selling tickets at a rate we did back in the days, but the tournament will be a cosy and well organised event. The tournament will continue to be organised by our club "Rollespilsforeningen Dragonfactory" and partners as a tribute to our fantastic community here in Denmark.

BRB24 is a 5 games AoS event scheduled the 26th and 27th of October 2024 in our venue in Ballerup. It is set to be an 70 player tournament. It will reintroduce some new and old traditions, both on the social level, as well on tournament level. It will be our playground as TO's, and we kindly ask for all participants to play along.

The venue will be open from Saturday at 09.00 hours.

- Gamesystem: Age of Sigmar
- Scale: 2000 points matched play pitched battle
- Army restrictions: Only FAQed armies allowed. See "rules allowed"
- Painting requirements: Fully painted armies, with at least 3 colours and based (The old minimum standard). First time attendees can apply for
- Pairing system: Swiss-draw, using the milarki.com homepage (please have a profile ready or pre-participate in the system).
- Army list submission deadline 22st of october 2024 10pm.

List must be submitted in readable format or the Aos App format and uploaded through Milarki to the tournament. See direct link.

Lists submitted after this date cannot win any prizes or podiums at our event.

WYSIWYG & Conversions

Conversions and alternative miniatures are welcome, as long as it upholds the idea of what it represents, and it has an overall comparison in size with what it represents.

WYSIWYG is a strong and clear rule that we will uphold, but we are allowing it to be bent a little e.g. to pregame present your blood reavers with either axes or blades as long as it is clearly stated on your army list. Another example could be with conversions, where a giant angel represents a Celestant Prime. We hope you get the idea. If you are in doubt, feel free to contact us.

Scoring

Scoring for every match uses the "worlds differential system". The matches is decided by *Battle Points*

A total of 20 battle points are divided between the players based on difference in Victory Points or Victory Size. See the table from Milarki homepage.

Soft scores:

Nominated to best painted = 10 points

Best sportsmanship = Votes x 2 (0-8 points) +2 points for best sportsmanship.

Duly submitted army list = 10 points

Soft score points will be added to the total score from all 5 battles to generate final tournament scoring. 1st. 2nd and 3rd place is determined by the number of points a player gets, soft scores included.

Best Sportsmanship is the highest ranked player without soft scores getting the most sportsmanship votes. Votes are differs from 0 to 4 votes

Best Painted (3-4 armies will be nominated for player votation). The single army with the most votes wins the prize.
